Central Content Publishing System (CCPS)

- Allocate a dedicated space on the homepage for publishing the content/graphics to display key information about the government decisions, schemes, programs, and achievements
- Standardize dissemination of information across digital footprint, ensuring that citizens have access to the impactful, relevant, and up-to-date information & messaging
- Subscribe to the APIs from the DBIM Toolkit and integrate with designated digital platforms





CCPS Components

- Banners (Full width & Short width)
- Overlay Banner
- Central Posts







Banners

- Full Width Banners across the full width of a homepage, making them suitable for high-impact announcements or promotional content
 - It is mandatory to publish 1st banner by CCPS on all Ministry, Department, and Organization websites. However, service platforms will have the flexibility to place it in 2nd or 3rd position
- Short-Width Designed for smaller display areas, providing flexibility in content arrangement

Overlay Banner

- Automatically appears on top of the homepage of subscribed websites as a pop-up.
- Depends on important announcements i.e. it may or may not be enabled at any given point in time.








Central Posts

- Provide various types of content, including images, videos, and PDF files.
- Allocated 960x245 pixels for publishing the centrally pushed posts.
- Multiple layout options are possible
- Subscribers must integrate the API in their respective websites to support and publish the posts in specified layouts.







Layout Options












CCPS Onboarding
